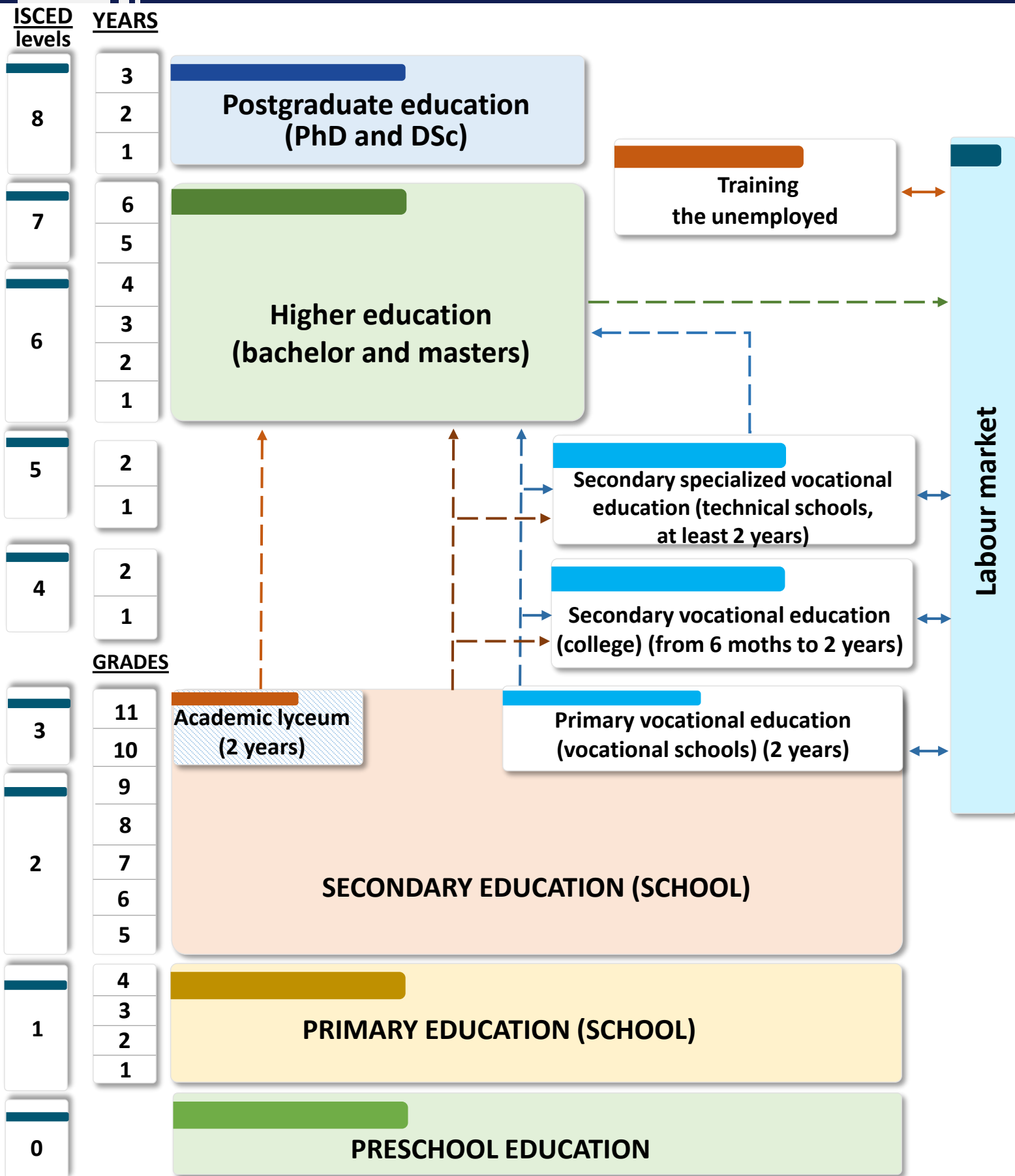

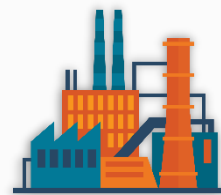
LEGISLATION

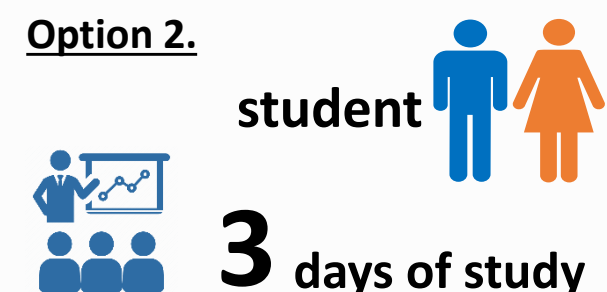


DUAL EDUCATION PROCESS
